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**Abstract**

The problem of interdisciplinary integration is highly relevant in modern school education, since the actualization of metadisciplinary connections in the process of studying courses and individual topics helps to their positive interaction. The purpose of the article is to identify the basis for the integration of knowledge in the study of philosophical issues in the course of social studies and lyrics by F.I. Tyutchev in 10th grade.

The methodological basis of the study was the provisions on the possibility of meta-subject integration in the theory of learning, integration of philosophical and literary knowledge in the study of school courses in social studies and literature, cognitive and system-activity approaches in creating the proposed didactic model.

Describing didactic results, the authors show which topics of the social science course contribute to a deeper understanding of the works of F.I. Tyutchev and how the poet's lyrics can clearly and figuratively explain the complexity of philosophical theories. Analysis of poems illustrating the main themes and motives of his poetry is carried out in the context of understanding the eternal questions of life: the problems of man and his relationship with the Universe, the meaning of life, philosophy of history and such moral categories as love, patriotism, religious consciousness.

Metadisciplinary interaction of literature and social studies helps students learn how to apply social science knowledge to understand poetry and see in it a reflection of philosophical categories and value concepts, which contributes to the awareness of unity and a holistic spiritual picture of the world.

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### **Use of the method of modeling in the formation of self-control of younger schoolchild**

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#### **Abstract**

The author of the article considers the problem of development of self-control as one of the components of educational activity. On the one hand, this algorithm is necessary for the successful execution of an action, and on the other hand, it serves as the basis for the implementation of process control. 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### **Methodological substantiation of construction of monitoring indicators of innovative development of educational organization**

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## **Abstract**

The rapid growth of the role of education in modern society requires it to reach a fundamentally new level, ensuring the formation of a person able to live in a rapidly changing environment, to originally development, to effectively address the problems and challenges they face. One of the most important reasons that hampers change and high rates of development in educational institutions is the lack of a methodologically sound system of monitoring indicators of innovative development, built relative to the horizon of innovative events. Our goal is a methodological justification for the construction of such a system on the basis of discrete modeling of an educational organization as an object of innovative development. A preschool educational organization is considered as a case for discrete modeling, where it is an object of innovative development and the modeling was carried out consistently on several descending levels. The first level provides a distinction in the integrated educational system of its main subsystems: "Students" and "Educational resource". The second level defines the relevant grounds for monitoring. The third level defines the thematic areas of monitoring for each subsystem. At the fourth level, support elements are created that specify the content of each direction in its main points; the fifth level provides for the formation of a system of indicators to assess the development of subsystems "Students" and "Educational Infrastructure" in each direction of monitoring. The authors substantiate the expediency of expanding the composition and changing the structure of currently used indicators. The authors identify the thematic areas of integrated assessment of two interrelated subsystems - "Students" and "Educational resource", and also formulate the requirements for building a system of indicators for each subsystem and determine the logic and levels of construction.

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## **Russian regional education: methodology of strategic analysis**

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**Abstract**

The authors have analysed the regional strategic documents for the development of education. The purpose of the analysis is to identify the main directions of modernisation of the education system at the regional level.

The analysis of strategic documents for the development of education was carried out on the basis of the following methodological approaches: regional, competency-based approach, variable-adaptive, successive, diversified. The basic principles of these approaches have constructed a model of the subject of the study and allowed the researchers to draw conclusions.

The analysis of regional socio-economic strategies of development and state programmes of the development of education show that the strategic development targets correspond to the content of the law on education and other national documents. The authors are creatively building functional, value, marketing, personnel and resource aspects of strategies. The institutional environment and coordination mechanisms in regional planning are being investigated. Some regions instead of strategic planning have developed educational development programmes that do not allow presenting a complete concept with new priorities in socio-economic conditions. However, there are disadvantages in some regions that include: controversy over assessing the level of needs of the population; inconsistency in the geographical, socio-economic, geopolitical, ethnic and natural peculiarities of a region; the insufficiency of bringing regional education in line with international trends towards the development of education; ignoring the problem of the development of continuing education; violation of continuity with the state of education of a region in previous periods; lack of analysis of achievements and errors, as well as the forecast of the development of education in the region for the near and distant future.

At the final stage of the research, the analysis of regional strategies has confirmed the inconsistency in documents along with the one in organisational and forecast indicators.

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**The enforcements of legal acts in the field of general education of Russia in the organizational and managerial activities of Nikolai I. Pirogov as a trustee of the educational district**

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**Abstract**

The author of the article presents sources that allow to review in detail the activities of the outstanding 19<sup>th</sup> century Russian pedagogue Nikolai I. Pirogov, who served as trustee of the Kiev

and Odessa educational districts. The author paid special attention to the issue of implementation of legal acts in the field of general education, which were intensively updated during this period of time. The underinvestigated aspects of Pirogov's socio-pedagogical and public activities are revealed in the article basing on the analysis of recent publications devoted to his scientific and educational life. It is noted, that Nikolai I. Pirogov considered pedagogical reality not as the mirror of regulatory requirements, but as an inevitably inconsistent process of due and existing in the field of general education. In this regard, Nikolai I. Pirogov strongly urged primary and secondary teachers to find a balance between the reasonable pedagogical requirements and applicable regulations, as well as suggested a number of mechanisms for solving this problem.
